## Staff Objectives:

- 1. Place the maximum worth on people and treat each individual with respect and significance.
- 2. Encourage Christ-like behavior.
- 3. Provide a quality learning environment and promote a wholesome community with godly role models and a high degree of accountability.
- 4. Provide instruction in a way that will motivate and encourage students.
- 5. Provide a safe and positive learning environment for the children.
- 6. Explain assignments so students have a clear understanding.

## Code of Conduct Expectations for the student:

- 1. All interactions with staff and other students should be cooperative and respectful.
- 2. No cell phones or electronic devices are to be used during class time.
- 3. Come to class on time and be prepared to work.
- 4. Complete all assignments to the best of your ability.
- 5. Respect the rights of others to learn without disruption, which includes, but is not limited to:
  - a. Use appropriate language and gestures.
  - b. Avoid creating distracting noises.
  - c. Remain in the designated area(s) unless you receive approval to leave.
  - d. Keep your hands to yourself.
- 6. Show respect for the church(es) that we rent by not roughhousing or running. If anything becomes damaged or broken, alert the teacher(s) to make sure proper responsibility is taken and the item(s) are fixed.
- 7. Modest clothing, which is appropriate for dancing and movement, should be worn to all class times.
- 8. Commit to all class times and let your teacher know if you will not be able to make a class.

## Consequences:

1st offense - Staff member(s) will talk to the student about their behavior.

2nd offense - Staff member(s) will talk to the student and the parent about their behavior.

3rd offense - Staff member(s) will bring the situation to the Theater Director, who will work with the family to find a solution, which may include dismissal or suspension from the Bright Rising Arts and Education program.
