Student Code of Conduct

This Student Code of Conduct clarifies our organization's mission, values and objectives and defines the expectations we have for student behavior, as it is only *because* of our students that this organization exists. This Code of Conduct should be considered a benchmark against which student and organizational performance can both be measured.

Mission Statement: Connecting kids to Christ through excellence and joy in the arts and academics.

Organizational Values and Objectives:

- * Placing the maximum worth on people and treating every individual with respect and significance.
- * Developing virtuous character values in individuals.
- * Providing a high-quality learning environment and promoting a wholesome community with godly role models and a high degree of accountability.

Behavior Expectations:

- * Respectful speech and interactions with all staff, as well as with other students, is expected at all times.
- * Any behavior or speech that may be considered harassing, intimidating or bullying, including actions, words or jokes designed to humiliate, shame or threaten, will not be tolerated.
- * Profanity is strictly prohibited.
- * All topics of conversation must be appropriate for *all* ages and should be absent of any mature content (*e.g.*, sexuality, gender, ethnic group, class, status, etc.).
- * Students must be respectful of the church property and follow guidelines, including no roughhousing or running in the building. Treat the property of the church as if it were your own and be careful not to do any damage.
- * Students must assist in cleaning up after themselves and help at the end of classes to clean up the general area and/or classroom.
- * Modest clothing must be worn at all times.
- * No cell phone or electronic devices are to be used by students. Staff will be available to contact parents, if needed.
- * Refrain from any physical contact or public expressions of affection.
- * For theater production crew and performance cast: you must be available to be at performances and tech/dress rehearsals except in cases of emergency.
- * Come prepared, on-time, and ready to focus, pay attention, and work hard in all classes and rehearsals.
- * Violations of any of the above behavioral expectations may be reviewed by the Board of Directors and may result in suspension and/or expulsion from classes/theater.
